



What you told us	Changes we're making
1. You had difficulty seeing your regular GP	Making sure we have enough appointments is important for our clinic to provide the best health care. We try to ensure efficiency whilst booking appointments so patients can have access to their regular GP. We have welcomed Dr Bernadette Hunt and Dr Keshav Faye-Chauhan to our team which will free up appointments for the other GPs.
